### **Kindergarten Book Club**

#### **Eligible Students: K**

Do you love books? Then this is the club for you! We will meet approximately two Thursdays a month until December to enjoy the Building Block Books which are part of the Missouri Library Association's student choice program. We will read each of the nominees and do some related crafts and activities for some of the books. At the end of the program each child will vote for his/her favorite one.
